Design and Research Agenda of Studio 101 & 111

Introduction to basic concepts and general trait of design. Abstraction and conceptualisation. Design exercises at various scales and complexities. Development of mental, perceptual and manual skills in the presentation of design ideas. The course aims to introduce students to basic design principles and general traits of design by developing manual and mental skills to advance in "hands on practices" at various mediums. It expects student to get competent in visual and compositional organization strategies and be able to test different design approaches concurrently. The acquired basic skills are expected to be utilised in analysing, describing and enriching the series of relations between the elements of a composition and to foster a capability to manipulate form and space, thus gaining dexterity to represent the perceptual and mental process through various media. The students are expected to develop an understanding of abstraction, form relations and basic formal properties such as geometry, size, scale, and light. The course introduces the thematic volumetric and compositional concepts in achieving order and in developing awareness to the surrounding related to basic design principles. It also initiates engagement with a variety of media and communication techniques.
