TEDU policies on smoking is implemented within the following framework. These rules cover academic and administrative staff, students and visitors within TEDU. The *Internal Services Officer* is responsible for the regulation, monitoring and implementation of the rules. To this end,

- Smoking and use of other tobacco products are prohibited at locations where health, educational and cultural services are conducted according to the *Law No. 4207 on Prevention and Control of Hazards of Tobacco Products* and sanctions are to be imposed against violators.
- The consumption of cigarettes and other tobacco products is prohibited in all enclosed spaces on the campus for the safety and well-being of TED University members and visitors in accordance with the *Law No. 4207 on Prevention and Control of Hazards of Tobacco Products*.
- The following locations are designated and marked as smoking areas on the campus;
 - İncesu Campus - Block B outdoor area behind the ATM point,
 - Aksu Campus - the area between Block C cafeteria and Block E ground floor terrace exit
 - Aksu Campus - The designated area between Blocks E and H.
 - Aksu Campus - The designated area between Block D Aksu Street,
- It is not allowed to consume cigarettes and other tobacco products at other locations than those specifically designated.
- Private Security Officers are responsible for keeping a record of those who do not comply with the warnings and notifications.
